

Respite Care Provider Grants

Respite Care Association of Wisconsin (RCAW) is looking to fund direct respite care hours to underserved populations.

The Respite Care Provider Grants will be available twice a year to increase direct respite care services to existing and start-up programs that provide services to underserved populations. Priority is given to programs serving rural communities, Native American Tribes, Hispanic/Latino, African American, or Hmong families, Relatives as caregivers (i.e. Grandfamilies), and children and families in crisis (high risk for abuse and neglect). Other populations will be considered as well. A program is eligible to apply for this grant if they will be providing direct respite care in the next three months.

RCAW will be offering these grant funds over the next few years because of a grant received through the Federal Lifespan Respite Grant program and a partnership with the WI Department of Health Services. Request for proposals will be released a couple of times each year.

CRITERIA FOR FALL 2022 Respite Care Provider Grants

- The program must provide respite care in Wisconsin
- Grant requests should be \$4,000 or less
- Direct respite care hours will be provided during the Winter of 2022-2023
- Grant funds should be used for direct respite services. Examples include:
 - Covering the program fees for individuals in the identified populations
 - o Creating new respite programs that target an underserved population
 - Expanding existing programs to underserved populations
 - Staff costs, program supplies, activities, rental space, etc. that relate to providing respite to underserved populations.

IMPORTANT DATES

September 7, 2022 – Grant Application Released

October 14, 2022 – Grant applications are due by midnight, CST.

November 1, 2022 – Grant Awards will be announced, checks will be mailed.

February 28, 2023 – One-time Progress Report Due (1-page reporting on impact, participants served, and hours of provided respite care)

- 5. How many people do you estimate will be touched by these grant funds?
- 6. How many hours of direct respite service do you plan on providing because of these funds?
