3. Not make any changes to, or use only certain NRCPT core curriculum courses, as it may render the training as no longer meeting the NRCPT Professional Core Competencies.
 - a. If you wish to make changes to NRCPT core curriculum courses or only utilize some of the courses, you must no longer claim nor represent that the training meets the NRCPT Professional Core Competencies and no longer use the NRCPT logo to promote training on any marketing materials, websites, social media, etc.
 - i. All modified NRCPT courses must acknowledge the excerpts or portions of the NRCPT training used in whole or in part by stating in writing within

the course: *“This information or training was adapted/modified from the National Respite Care Provider Training™ and may no longer meet the competency standards or fidelity of the original NRCPT.”*

- ii. Additionally, you can no longer provide a training certificate of completion titled with the National Respite Care Provider Training, NRCPT, nor utilize the nationally approved NRCPT logo in the training.

The training certificate’s purpose is solely to indicate that an individual has completed the NRCPT. Because the training certificate is not a certification, accreditation, or license, the NRCPT cannot be promoted or marketed in any way that would imply that the training certificate is certifying, accrediting, or licensing anyone by RCAW, or any government or licensing agency.
5. Not sell, charge, or monetize the access or use of the NRCPT Toolkit, including the NRCPT.
6. You may share the request form to request a link to the NRCPT Toolkit with anyone who is interested in accessing it. However, you cannot share the link, password, and login you receive to access the NRCPT Toolkit and Toolkit directly with anyone else OUTSIDE of your specific agency, corporation, government entity, or organization.
