On January 28, 2025, we announced the difficult decision to pause our respite grant programs due to potential funding constraints. These programs provide essential relief for family caregivers.

Since then, our dedicated team has worked tirelessly in crisis prevention mode, devising contingency plans for the organizational programs that serve so many. We recognize that family caregiving is a 24/7 responsibility, and respite care is often the only way caregivers can take a much-needed break. We are pleased to announce an update to our grant programs effective **February 18, 2025.**

- 1. Emergency Use of the Caregiver Respite Grant Program Reopened

- 2. Supplemental Respite Grant Program <u>Reopened</u>
- 3. Caregiver Respite Grant Program (CRGP)— *Reopened with Modified Eligibility*
 - The CRGP is reopened to family caregivers who have never applied for this grant (new applicants) or reapplicants whose last respite date has not been in the last 180 days.
- 4. Group Respite Grant Program Paused
- 5. StartUP Grant Program Paused
