WHAT IS NRCPT?

The National Respite Care Provider Training (NRCPT) is a free, online training designed to prepare respite providers to care for and support children, adults, and older adults. It equips providers to serve individuals with a wide range of disabilities and support needs across the lifespan. Whether you are:

- A new or experienced respite provider or volunteer
- A family caregiver looking for trained support
- A state or state agency building workforce capacity

NRCPT helps strengthen the quality, safety, and accessibility of respite care.

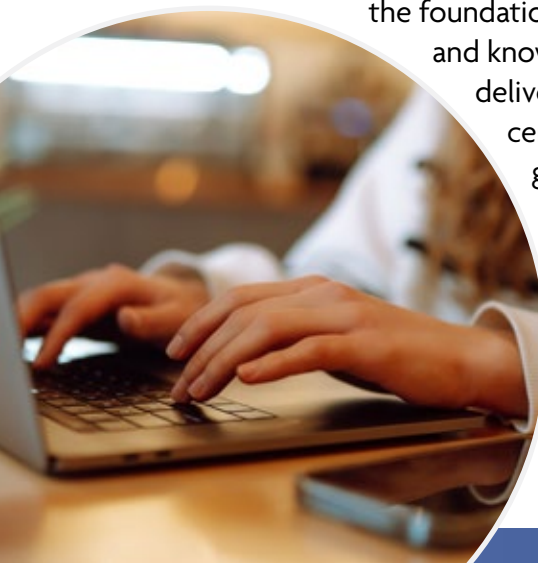
WHY TRAINING MATTERS
